

Bancroft-Rosalie Community Schools Educational Foundation 2010 Scholarship Criteria

The Bancroft-Rosalie Community Schools Educational Foundation is offering five (5) scholarships in the amount of \$150 each to graduates of the Class of 2010.

Criteria for these scholarships include:

- All graduating seniors in the Bancroft-Rosalie Class of 2010 are eligible.
- Students seeking this scholarship must have a cumulative grade point average of 81 or above.
- Students seeking this scholarship must complete the application form and return it to the Guidance Counselor by **March 30**.
- Scholarship funds awarded will be paid at the beginning of the second semester of the first year of enrollment at an institution of higher education (including college, university, community college, or vocational school). The scholarship check will be made payable to both the student and the institution of higher education that the student is attending. The check will be mailed directly to the Financial Aid Office or comparable office of said institution.
- At least one scholarship will be awarded to a student attending a community college or vocational/technical school unless there are no qualifying applications from students attending a community college or vocational/technical school.
- At least two alternate students will also be selected and shall be designated Alternate 1 and Alternate 2. Alternates shall receive one of the scholarships in the event awardees decline the scholarship or in the event any awardees are not enrolled in an institution of higher education at the time scholarships are paid. If alternates receive scholarship funds they will be awarded first to Alternate 1 and then to Alternate 2.
- General criteria for scholarship selection include: community service; community involvement; academic record; extracurricular involvement; and future educational, occupational and career plans.
