

HOPE for Sudan

Scholarship At the University of Nebraska

The Hope for Sudan Scholarship Fund will begin making awards of \$2,000 in the fall of 2010, adding one scholarship recipient annually until four students will benefit from the award in 2013. All incoming and current students are eligible for this new scholarship.

Students admitted to any University of Nebraska campus are eligible. To apply, students must complete an essay of no more than 500 words describing how events in the nation of Sudan have directly or indirectly affected their own lives. Scholarship recipients will be chosen largely on the basis of the essay. In addition, preference will be given to applicants who speak one of several dialects native to southern Sudan, the most common being Dinka and Neuer.

Essays should be submitted with a cover letter that includes the applicant's name and contact information, as well as the name and contact information of one personal reference. Materials must be received by the end of the business day on Monday, Feb. 15. Materials may be mailed to:
