

## Rosalie Alumni Association Scholarship

The Rosalie Alumni Association offers two (2) \$500.00 scholarships annually to deserving Bancroft-Rosalie graduates who meet the following criteria.

1. Must have a cumulative grade-point average of 85% or above.
2. Must have attended Bancroft-Rosalie High School a minimum of 2-3 years.
3. Must be a resident of the Bancroft-Rosalie School District or have a family member who graduated from Rosalie High School, or Bancroft-Rosalie High School.
4. Must be present at the Rosalie Alumni Banquet to speak about your qualifications and accept your scholarship. Banquet is held on the Saturday preceding Memorial Day at Rosalie.
5. Must include at least two (2) recommendations from B-R teachers and a guidance counselor.
6. Must include a complete description of community service.
7. Must include a transcript of high school classes, credits, and attendance.
8. Scholarship is awarded annually if graduates qualify.
9. Must fully complete the attached application and return to the B-R guidance office to be forwarded to the Alumni Scholarship committee by March 30, 2010.
10. The Rosalie Alumni Scholarship Committee will select recipients from those who meet or exceed the qualifications.
11. Scholarship is to be paid following successful completion of the first semester and enrollment in the second semester of the recipient's freshman year. Scholarship check will be made out to both the student and the college the recipient is attending. The check will be mailed to the Financial Aid Office of the college.
